GET READY FOR "DREAM NIGHT"

Mark your calendars for August 22nd in anticipation that you will participate in moving forward with our plans for building our new facilities on Springdale Road!

I want to begin by thanking Architect Selection Task Force co-chairs, Alex Brown and Nicholas Gibson, and the

committee members for their diligent work and innumerable hours conducting a thorough process for selecting an architect for designing our new facilities. After an extensive process, our Architect Selection Committee interviewed several architectural firms and narrowed the list to three finalists, which were presented to me for final selection. After prayerful consideration and thorough research, I decided upon Shanks Architects in Dallas. In addition, I engaged the Austin law firm, Allensworth and Porter – top legal experts on construction law – on the Shanks Architects' contract proposal. Negotiations with Shanks Architects were undertaken, and we came to a mutually agreed-upon contract to govern the relationship between Shanks Architects and David Chapel. Allensworth and Porter will continue to advise us as we finalize contracts with consultants and contractors.






