Difference" were dedicated at the African American Cultural and Heritage Facility at 912 East 11th Street. The portraits form the border of a mosaic mural titled "Reflections" in the courtyard of the facility and are on view at all times. The late police Captain Louis White, who was a David Chapel deacon, was another one of the honorees.

Pastor Parker gave the invocation after which the names of the honorees and their achievements were read by Dr. Chiquita Watt Eugene, mistress of ceremonies. Also appearing on the program was Mayor Pro Tem Sheryl Cole, a David Chapel member.



The African American Resource Advisory Commission selected people for the Portrait Project "who have made a long-lasting impact in the city and who were—or continue to be—pioneers in their areas of service." New portraits will be added to the mural annually.
