PASTOR PARKER ANSWERS YOUR QUESTIONS ABOUT THE UNITED WE BUILD CAMPAIGN AND THE NEW FACILITY

What is the current status of the project?

- Our architectural firm has provided strategic planning/programming, site analysis, concept design, master planning (including the Dream Night process) services, and the probable construction costs for Phase 1 of our project.
- The architects estimate an approximate \$6 million construction cost for Phase One at today's costs.
- Here is an update of the United We Build Capital Campaign:
 - <u>Pledges</u> made beginning in May, 2011 total \$727,762 and <u>contributions</u> received toward these pledges as of February 10, 2015, total \$533,302. Currently, nearly \$200,000 in campaign pledges remain unpaid. Over the last three years, we have made expenditures of \$100,675 for campaign costs, architectural/engineering services and various other needs associated with the land site. This leaves us with an <u>available</u> <u>balance under the UWB Campaign</u> of \$432,627, as of February 10, 2015.
- As you can see, our available UWB balance is not sufficient to build Phase One. To realize our vision for Phase One, we must fulfill all of our UWB financial pledges and demonstrate our financial ability and willingness to pay a monthly mortgage. If we financed \$3 million of the \$6 million, our loan payment is estimated to be about \$25,000 a month.
- We need to raise more funds toward the construction cost and demonstrate our ability to pay a mortgage note.

What is the projected move in date?

There is no projected move-in date, because it depends on the financial support that is given to the project.

PASTOR PARKER ANSWERS YOUR QUESTIONS, CONTINUED.

What will happen to the current facility?

The church has not made a decision as to what will happen to the current facility, but it will be a part of the financial strategy to pay for our new facility, whether it is sold completely or developed with a partner.

What was decided on the exterior design of the new facility?

The exterior design of the building was shown in the 3-D presentation that our architects made to the congregation. Plans are underway to display that design again to our members.

How much money is still needed in order to move to the new facility?

- As of February 10, 2015, the available UWB balance was \$432,627. Construction of Phase One of the project is estimated to cost \$6 million at today's prices.
- We want to have at least \$3 million "in-hand" with the demonstrated ability to finance \$3 million for Phase One. We are hopeful that at least half of the Phase One construction cost can be generated from our current facility and adjacent properties.

Will a church wide meeting be held to update everyone at some point down the road?

There is no church-wide meeting currently scheduled, but there will be "at some point down the road," because the congregation will need to make some decisions to go forward.

What has become of the surveys and input that was provided to the architects?

The architects used the information from Dream Night and the surveys in developing the concept design for Phase One and the Master Plan.
